Ismail pictured in white is one of the trainers volunteering with Solar Clutch. He took the initiative to begin a program in the Nuba Mountain region of Sudan. This area lies between North and South Sudan and is a political hot spot with the recent discovery of oil. For Ismail it is a great solar cooker "HOT SPOT" for a new initiative. The women leave the village to tend the farms each morning and don't return till late in the evening. The solar cooker offers a natural way to prepare the family meal without fear of their children being burned by an accidental fire.

The women enjoyed the cooked food and Ismail has sent word back "We need more cookers"

The cost of making a plastic cooker as shown in the picture, sending it air cargo to Sudan, buying a pot for a woman and training her how to use the cooker all costs us \$30.

Getting them to Nuba Mountains has been an additional cost for Ismail as well as the extra cost to get these cookers to Darfur.
